## The Loving Compassion and Gentleness of Jesus

Jesus exclaimed: "I bless you, Father, Lord of Heaven and earth, for hiding these things from the learned and the clever, and revealing them to mere children. Yes, Father, for that is what it pleased you to do. Everything has been entrusted to me by my Father; and no one knows the Son except the Father, just as no one knows the Father except the Son and those to whom the Son chooses to reveal him. Come to me, all you who labour and are overburdened, and I will give you rest. Shoulder my yoke upon, and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you shall find rest for your souls. Yes, my yoke is easy and my burden light."

These words from our Gospel today help us to appreciate the gentle compassion of the Son of God for each one of us. We like Jesus are invited to be the yoke for those who are burdened from time to time. We are invited to be compassionate and supportive to those who struggle. We are invited to walk with those who find life difficult or cannot see the way ahead. Compassion, love, kindness and sensitivity to others in need, is a not just a basic human quality, it is the most natural way to respond. Not to reach out an support is neglect and reject and not a loving way to respond. **Entrance Antiphon:** Your merciful love, O God, we have received in the midst of your temple. Your praise, O God, like your name, reaches the ends of the earth; your right hand is filled with saving justice.
