Prepare

There is an air of expectancy as we make our final preparations for the celebration of the birth of Christ. In the letter of St James, (today's second reading), he uses the image of the farmer waiting patiently 'for the precious fruit of the ground until it has had the autumn rains and the spring rains'. So James reminds us that we have to be patient and not lose heart as we prepare for the important celebrations in our lives. Preparing to celebrate Christmas is a little like waiting for the crop to ripen, the bread to rise, the flower to bloom, the baby to be born. All these events in life require that we spend time preparing ourselves and those around us.

As we move into this third week of Advent may it be a time of reflective preparation, focusing on the Birth of Christ and the ways in which we as families will gather to share our love around the table of the Lord and the table of our families.
