Pope Francis has published his long-awaited encyclical Laudato Si' on our relationship with the whole of creation. The encyclical places the care of creation, our 'common home', at the heart of Christian theology. He calls on our fragile world to leave behind the myth of unlimited material progress and proposes instead a 'sense of fraternity that excludes nothing and no one' and an understanding of the Earth as a 'shared inheritance'. Catholic Earthcare Australia has provided a list of main themes of the encyclical and some practical actions for us all. Joseph Camilleri, an emeritus professor from La Trobe University, and Andrew Hamilton SJ have written insightful local initial reviews of the encyclical for our reflection. Please join us for a Breakfast Briefing: Pope Francis and the Care of our Common Home, with Australian delegate Jacqui Rémond, Director of Catholic Earthcare Australia. Jacqui was part of a small delegation of six Global Catholic Climate Movement (GCCM) members who met with His Holiness Pope Francis and joyfully received the Pope's encyclical.
