The Mercy of God

Today the Gospel shares with us the Transfiguration of Jesus to his friends and Apostles, Peter, James & John, on the mountain. This event was to prepare them for the Resurrection of Jesus after his Passion and Death.

By showing himself to them in a glorified state Jesus expressed the love and mercy of God - sacrificing Himself to give us life. The words of the Father, "This is my Son, the Chosen One. Listen to him" echo for each one of us the challenge to listen and know we are loved. Parents do exactly the same for their children as they show their children a way through life and often say, 'Listen to me', in words and actions, helping their children to make right and appropriate decisions. In many ways we could acknowledge that our parents have been like the Lord as we pray in our Responsorial Psalm today,
