# Who do you say I am?

I wonder if you ever would like to ask the question of yourself, to another: 'Who do people say I am?'. Perhaps we are too afraid to ask. Is it out of fear the answer we receive, we may not like to hear? Do we think the response would not be honest or perhaps too honest? Maybe we should ask someone who knows us well, seeking an honest response. In this way you may have a better understanding of yourself. This also may offer you an opportunity for growth and sensitivity in the way you live. How others see us is not always the way we see ourselves. Jesus knows this so well as we reflect upon his public ministry presented in the Gospels.

Jesus in our Gospel today asks this question not to know more about himself. Asking Jesus allows the apostles to express their faith and recognition of the Son of God in their presence.

Jesus then make a profound statement, "Because it was not flesh and blood that reveled this to you but my Father in heaven." Here lives the difference. Flesh and blood are only the means by which we are able to express what lives within. It is spirit, the essence of who we are, that seeks relationships and a relationship with the spiritual, the divine.
