

The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi) —Year C — 19 June 2022

REFLECTION

This Feast combines the previous feasts of Corpus Christi and the Precious Blood of Christ. It reminds us that the body and blood of Christ were offered as a sacrifice for us, and every time we re-enact this sacrifice, we renew his sacrifice. The Body and Blood of Jesus is the interim meal for the Christian until the Lord returns. We see character of Christian already returned. 

World Meeting of Families—June 22-26

From June 22-26, delegates from around the world will gather in Rome with Pope Francis for the World Meeting of Families. But it's not just an event for the select few in Rome. The Pope has also encouraged local families to celebrate the occasion in parishes and dioceses. Here are some ways you can do this.



Meal Time = Prime-Time

Meals are prime time for family, where life is shared and values are formed.

Some tips:

- Turn off the TV & smart phones so that you can be present to each other.
- Say a prayer of thanks for the meal: gratitude reminds us of our blessings.
- Don't rush it. Allow time to enjoy the food AND the conversation.
- Listen. Catch up on each other's day. It can be helpful to have a standard question: What was your high? What was your low?
- Keep conversation respectful. Affirm, don't criticise. Humour can defuse tension.
- Be persistent—even if your attempts end in

A reading from the holy Gospel according to Luke.

Jesus made the crowds welcome and talked to them about the kingdom of God; and he cured those who were in need of healing.

It was late afternoon when the Twelve came to him and said, ‘Send the people away, and they can go to the villages and farms round about to find lodging and food; for we are in a lonely place here.’ He replied, ‘Give them something to eat yourselves.’ But they

said, ‘We have no more than five loaves and two fish, unless we are to go ourselves and buy food for all these people.’ For there were about five thousand men. But he said to his disciples, ‘Get them to sit down in parties of about fifty.’ They did so and made them all sit down. Then he took the five loaves and the two fish, raised his eyes to heaven, and said the blessing over them; then he broke them and handed them to his disciples to distribute among the crowd. They all ate as much as they wanted, and when the scraps remaining were collected they filled twelve baskets.
