REFLECTION

Most people love a parade, noisily making the most of a chance to come together with others of like mind, to celebrate an event or highlight an issue. Holy Week begins with a parade. People get really involved throwing down their garments and rejoicing at all the mighty works they have witnessed through Jesus. Jesus rides triumphant through it all and encourages his followers to praise God with loud voice. Parades can bring out the best, and worst, in people. It is hard not to get caught up in the emotion of the moment and events that were supposed to be happy and peaceful sometimes deteriorate into chaos and violence. How the parade mood changed over the course of Holy Week! In the long Gospel of the Passion, we see Jesus no longer triumphant but separated from his followers, insulted, struck, spat upon, and finally carrying the cross to crucifixion on Golgotha: 'He emptied himself to assume the condition of a slave ... even to accepting death on a cross.' What reaction do I have to today's readings? Has my Lenten journey prepared me to be really present during this Holy Week? "God's Word—Daily Reflections 2022)
