#### **Holy Trinity Sunday**



The feast of the Holy Trinity brings us face to face with the foundation of our faith. The readings for today provide answers to the question: Who is God? They can really only suggest something about the mystery of God, and they can do this only indirectly. They call to mind some of the wonders that God has accomplished for us and in us. It is through reflection on these gracious divine acts that we can get glimpses of God. The psalm declares that the harmony and interdependence that we see in creation point to a majestic creator responsible for it all. The account of the history of God's people reveals a God who desires to establish an intimate relationship with them, enters their history as protector and guide, and forgives disloyalty. Finally, Jesus teaches that God sent him into the world to save it, has made us adopted children through the Holy Spirit, and will ultimately clothe us in divine glory. It is from his teaching that we hear that the Son was sent by the Father, the Spirit, which was also his Spirit, proceeded from the Father and from him. From our own experience, we know that God creates, because we are immersed in creation. We know that God saves, because we have been freed from the bondage of our own demons. Our experience tells us that God is with us, and that God is for us. Everything that we know about God declares that God is passionately in love with us, boundlessly so!

#### **GLOBAL WEEK OF PRAYER FOR CHINA**

(From the Office of Fr Joe Caddy AM, Vicar General, Catholic Archdiocese of Melbourne)

"The Archbishop has asked that I bring to your attention the upcoming week of Prayer for the people of China in the week of 23-30 May 2021. As you may be aware, there are reports that the persecution of people of faith in China has increased in recent times. This not only includes Catholics and Christians, but also Buddhists, Muslims and other believers who are routinely persecuted, imprisoned and tortured. Earlier this year, the President of the Federation of Asian Bishops' Conferences, His Eminence Charles Cardinal Bo issued a call for a worldwide week of prayer for the Church and the people of China. We pray that all believers in in China are given the freedom to practice their faith and that human dignity and respect is always upheld and respected.

#### **Entrance Antiphon**

Blest be God the Father, and the Only Begotten Son of God, and also the Holy Spirit, for he has shown us his merciful love.

First Reading: Dt 4:32-34. 39-40

A reading from the book of Deuteronomy

Moses said to the people: 'Put this question to the ages that are past, that went before you, from the time God created man on earth: Was there ever a word so majestic, from one end of heaven to the other? #### 2021 National Count of Attendance at Mass

Every year we undertake a count of people attending Mass to gather information that will be used to assist in pastoral planning both in our parish and in the Archdiocese.

Every five years, coinciding with the Australian Government Census, this count is done on a national basis so that the Mass attendance data gathered can be used, in conjunction with the Census data,

to better understand and plan for the pastoral needs of the wider community.

This count will take place at St Patrick's and St Kevin's over the four weekends starting 8th May. It will be a simple headcount, however, this year parishes will also be asked to provide information on the age and sex of those who attend Mass: No other information about individual attenders will be collected.
