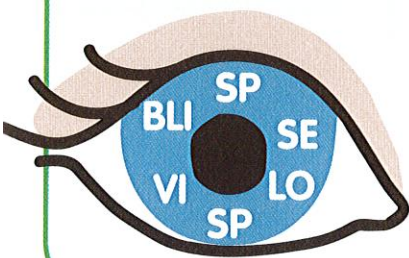

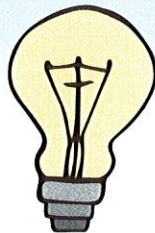

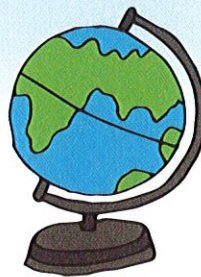
Can you see five words from today's Gospel in the grid? Start on the pink letters and look up, down, across and diagonally.
