- 4 for the Catholic community in Australia: that the deliberations of the Plenary Council will bear a rich harvest of renewal and revitalisation.

- For freedom from attachments: that God will give us the courage to live with less and embrace our families, our community members, and the gift of each day more fully.

- For the sick among us and for all who have asked for our prayers.
 For those who have died recently and those whose anniversaries occur at this time: may they now share in the heavenly banquet prepared for us all.
