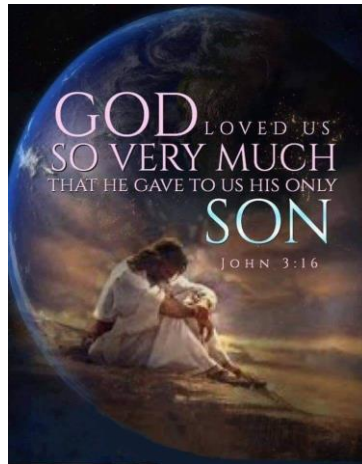

A fire has flames, heat, and light, but yet it is still just one fire.

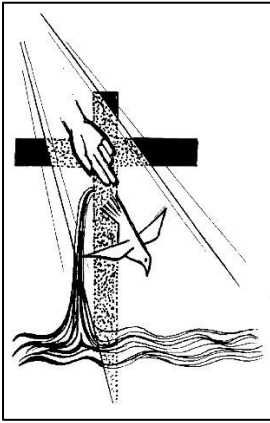
When you hear a person's speech, you are hearing three things - his words, his thoughts, and his voice, yet it is still one speech.

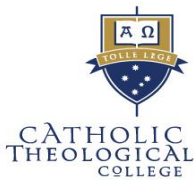
