This second Sunday of Advent we hear the voice of John the Baptist crying out "prepare a way for the Lord..." (Luke 3:4). The first reading from Baruch, who was the scribe or secretary of Jeremiah, probably speaking to the Israelite exiles in Babylon, savs "take of your dress of sorrow and distress, put on the beauty of the glory of God forever...." (Baruch 5:1). He goes on to say that, "God has decreed.....that Israel can walk in safety under the glory of God." (Baruch 5:7) We are called during this time of advent preparation to meditate on the 'Glory of God', which will protect us. There may be things. peoples, governments, organisations etc around us that may seem glorious, especially during this time of doubt and confusion that we are going through. But nothing or no one surpasses the GLORY OF GOD, which is revealed in CHRIST. He is the only one who can save us and our world. The best way to prepare the way for the Lord is by meditating and becoming aware of his awesomeness and his Glory.
