Gaudete Sunday is the third Sunday of Advent, from the word *Gaudete* ("Rejoice"), the first the introit or entrance antiphon of this weekend's Mass, from Philippians 4:4. The readings and the lighting of the pink candle in the Advent wreath this weekend reflect this joy. The text of the Annunciation in Luke 1:28 'chaire kecharitomene' which is 'Hail' or 'Rejoice, full of grace' is the name Mary possesses in God's sight. For the messenger greets Mary as "full of grace"; he calls her thus as if it were her real name. He does not call her by her proper name: Miriyam (= Mary), but by this new name: "full of grace" (Encyclical Letter Redemtoris Mater of the Supreme Pontiff, John Paul II, on the Blessed Virgin Mary in the Life of the Pilgrim Church, p. 8). The fact that should not be forgotten is that the announcement by the angel is unique in human history and thus the expression of 'chaire', which is 'Rejoice', is more suitable for this occasion. The invitation to joy is appropriate for the announcement of the coming of the Messiah. This text parallels this weekend's First Reading from the Old Testament oracle of the Prophet Zephaniah, "Sing aloud, O daughter of Zion; shout, O Israel! Rejoice and exult with all your heart, O daughter of Jerusalem!" (Zephaniah 3:14). There is a mention of the Lord's presence in verse 15, "The King of Israel, the Lord, is in your midst". There is the exhortation not to fear and the promise of God's saving presence, "Do not fear, O Zion; let not your hands grow weak. The Lord, your God, is in your midst, a warrior who gives victory" (16-17). The comparisons lead one to recognize Mary as the new "daughter of Zion", who has reason to rejoice since God has decided to fulfil his plan of salvation. We are called this Sunday to Rejoice with Mary, the Mother of our Lord and our Mother.
