This weekend's second reading from Paul's First Letter to the Corinthians speaks about the gifts. The last verse speaks of the gifts that endure: "three things that last: faith, hope and love and the greatest of these is love." (I Cor 13:13) These are the three theological virtues, which are the foundations of Christian living. A virtue is an habitual and firm disposition to do the good ... to give the best of one's self ... and according to St Gregory of Nyssa the goal of a virtuous life is to become like God (Cf CCC 1803). The greatest is love. 'Christ died out of love for us...The Lord asks us to love as he does, even our enemies, to make ourselves neighbour to those farthest away... (CCC 1825) Such love is superior to all other virtues.
