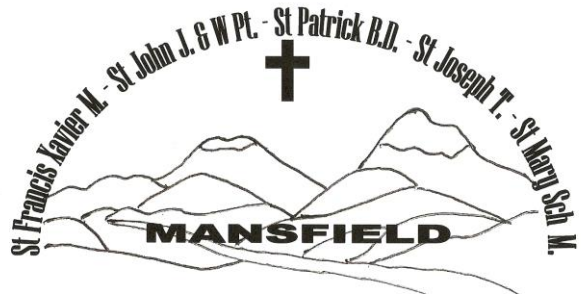

Youth Justice Chaplains also play a role in advocating for the dignity of young people, with in the youth justice system and across the broader community. People living with HIV/AIDS will often experience discrimination and /or social isolation. The HIV/AIDS Ministry provides a place of healing and community for people who are living with HIV/AIDS.

Your support and generosity will ensure that Catholic Chaplains can continue to be the messengers of God's mercy, love and compassion.
