The ancient Greeks saw six ways of love and they have six words for each. *Agápe* means "love: brotherly love, charity; the love of God for us and of our love for God". The other words are, *Eros* or sexual passion, *Philia* or deep friendship, *Storge* (*storgē*) means love or affection especially of parents and children, *Xenia* is an ancient Greek concept of hospitality, *Philautia* means self-love.

Agape is used in the Bible to express the unconditional love of God. This is further explained by St Thomas Aquinas as "to will the good of another" or "sacrificial love". This what we hear in this weekend's Gospel, to love God and neighbour (Mark 12: 30-31) selflessly. Agape, self-giving love needs to affect all other loves.
