To Trust the All Knowing

Aristotle begins his work *Metaphysics* ("meta" means 'after' /physica' means 'physics' or nature) with the observation 'All men by nature desire 'to know.' The question is 'How much do we know or can we know?' Some philosophical positions hold that humans can know everything, some others that humans can know nothing and others that we can know some things but not everything. In this weekend's gospel Jesus tells us about our limitedness in knowing and that there are things which is known by 'no one but the Father' (Mark 13:32). Since we are finite and limited beings our knowledge is also limited. Accepting this fact we are called in this weekend's gospel acclamation to be watchful and disposed to prayer which will lead us to trust in the Father who knows it all. We read in the Book of Proverbs: 'Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding.' To trust in the One who knows it all.
