

What is greatness? It is the quality of being great; eminence or distinction. William Shakespeare said, "Be not afraid of greatness. Some are born great, some achieve greatness, and others have greatness thrust upon them." This weekend's gospel show us the disciples of Jesus argue among themselves about 'which of them is the greatest' (Mark 9:34). They are having this discussion immediately after Jesus speaks to them about his impending suffering (Mark 9:31) because they could not understand it and were afraid to ask him (9:32).

Our Lord explains to his disciples that to be great is to be of 'service' and to 'receive even the smallest or least person (Jesus takes the example of a child) in His name' (Mark 9:35 -37).

We see this in the second reading with St James telling us that 'the wisdom that comes from above is essentially pure...makes for peace...is kindly...considerate....full of compassion and shows itself by doing good' (James 3:17-18). It is faith in action. We find this reflected in the in the words of St Teresa of Kolkata: 'Not all of us can do great things. But we can do small things with great love.'
