ANOINTING OF THE SICK

This weekend we will be offering the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. Here are a few points about this Sacrament...



Who receives this Sacrament?

The Anointing of the Sick is not only for those who are at the point of death. Hence, as soon as anyone of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him to receive this sacrament has certainly arrived.



What happens if I have a grave illness then recover?

If a sick person who received this anointing recovers his/her health, he/she can in the case of another grave illness receive this sacrament again. If during the same illness the person's condition becomes more serious, the sacrament may be repeated.



What if I am about to undergo a serious operation?

It is fitting to receive the Anointing of the Sick just prior to a serious operation. The same holds for the elderly whose frailty becomes more pronounced.



Who is able to administer this Sacrament?

Only priests (bishops and presbyters) are minister of the Anointing of the Sick



How is this Sacrament celebrated?

Like all sacraments the Anointing of the Sick is a liturgical and communal celebration, whether it takes place in the family home, a hospital or church, for a single sick person or a whole group of sick people. It is very fitting to celebrate it within the Eucharist, the memorial of Lord's Passover.



The effects of the celebration of this Sacrament

The special grace of the Anointing of the Sick has the its effect:

- The uniting of the sick person to the passion of Christ, for his own good and that of the whole Church;
- The strengthening, peace, and courage to ensure in a Christian manner the sufferings, illness or old age;
- The forgiveness of sins, if the sick person was not able to obtain it through the sacrament of Penance;
- The restoration of health, if it is conducive to the salvation of his/her soul;
- The preparation for passing over to eternal life.
