Are You A Volunteer / Helper at Our Parish?

It is the policy of the Catholic Archdiocese of Melbourne, and therefore the Catholic Parish of Melton (refer to our own Child Safety Parish Policy), that all adults (18 years and over) working in a Parish setting (either in a volunteer or paid capacity) must hold a WWCC with very limited exceptions. This is intended to cover employees, contractors and volunteers, and includes clergy, seminarians, and religious brothers and sisters.
