MESSAGE FROM FR MICHAEL—

Hello! I hope this message finds you well.

There has been no immediate change to the current state-of-play with Premier Dan Andrews' announcement of the COVID roadmap last Sunday. The next trigger, which is 70% of 16+ fully vaccinated, is when we can begin to meet outdoors. The number of how many can gather will be dependent on whether those in attendance are vaccinated or not. This distinction between vaccinated and non-vaccinated thresholds continue at each level of the roadmap. We will be able to meet indoors when 80% of 16+ are fully vaccinated. The indicative date for this is early-November.

In the meanwhile we are reviewing what we can do during this time. While we will continue to provide weekend Mass online, we would like to explore ways that we can provide some additional prayer opportunities. We will be extending an invitation for suggestions in the coming week of what you would like to see online to prepare you for returning to regular in-person Mass.

On 4 October, we will be holding our inaugural Pet Blessing online for the Feast day of St Francis of Assisi. Please be sure to look at Siena's personal invitation on Page 2 of The Tidings.

It would not be a grand final weekend without wishing both teams the best of luck for the game ahead. Remember to be gracious in winning as well as in defeat. Always remember—The pain for the team that does not hold the cup at the end is real!


