MESSAGE FROM FR MICHAEL—

Hello! I hope this message finds you well.

This week we have been working through the finer points of opening up in the new normal. On Thursday 7 October 2021, the acting Chief Health Officer, Professor Benjamin Cowie published changes relating to parish employees, parish volunteers and clergy. As a parish we will be subject to Mandatory Vaccination (Workers) Directions. The Melton Parish are now required to collect vaccination information for staff, volunteers and clergy. As a result we now are required to request that all volunteers provide their vaccination status to the Parish Office so we are able to comply with this CHO directive. An email or letter has been sent to all those on the roster. Thank you to all those that have already provided their vaccination certificates.

We are hoping that Mass will return on the weekend of 6/7 November 2021. There is a lot of work that needs to be done before this time. From the current information we have received, we will be able to have 150 fully vaccinated people inside the church. We will need to see hard copies/digital immunisation certificates. For this purpose, we ask you to download the digital certificate to your phone. This can be done via your Medicare online account that is linked to your myGov account. Next week we will have more information on how to do this along with any new information we receive about opening up.


