ST CATHERINE OF SIENA PRIMARY SCHOOL CELEBRATE'S THIER PATRON'S FEAST DAY.

Throughout the week, students learnt about who St Catherine of Siena was, all her works and her great faith. St Catherine of Siena, despite many hurdles, was committed to being the face of Jesus in the world. She helped the sick and the poor, wrote letters to politicians and church leaders and gave food and clothing to people in need. She is the patron saint of Italy, fire, Nurses and Illness.

Her famous quote is our school motto *'Be who God Made You to be and You Will Set the World on Fire.'*

In response to this, all year levels participated in an action that lived our motto and was influenced by the life of St Catherine.

These actions include:

- making hygiene packs for the poor
- making crosses and prayer card for our parishioners
- a framed picture of a dove with the names of children with their fingerprint along with a letter which will be given to the Ukrainian Bishop in Melbourne
- framed pictures for the local fire station, medical service and an aged care facility
- a stained glass image of St Catherine of Siena with self portraits of children as they can be like her and can be who God meant them to be and 'set the world on fire'
