MESSAGE FROM FR MICHAEL-

This weekend we will be changing the colours in the ceiling of the Church to help us reflect and pray for the current situation in the Ukraine. This year we selected HOPE as our Parish theme for the year. Traditionally, most of us start the year with such hope, with plans and dreams of what is to transpire in the year ahead. As the year progresses these hopes and plans are challenged. Sometimes by circumstance, sometimes by our reactions, sometimes by our choices. We can never be 100% sure where life will take us. Sometimes we can be lucky, sometimes we make our luck and sometimes even with trying our very best and making what appears to be the best possible choice, things do not go as planned. It at this point our faith is challenged. This is when we are put to the real test. The test is not are we right or wrong but do we have faith. Where do we find our hope, our place of solitude? What is our action plan then? How do we react? As Catholics we strive to find God in all we do. To see Him in the details of our lives. He asks us to trust and hope in Him and know that he works in all things. This is the challenging thing, there is no 'proof' at this point—only FAITH. The first line in this week's 1st reading is "In a shaken sieve the rubbish is left behind, so too the defects of a man in his talk". In our current world crisis we hear much. But the final line in Today's Gospel perhaps summarises it best... "For a man's words flow out of what fills his heart". We hope and we pray that in all our hearts, especially those called to show leadership at this time, have a change of heart—one that encompasses the LOVE we are called to show one another. We cannot <u>all</u> be right <u>all</u> of the time but we can LOVE and walk with God. We ask you to pray the prayer on Page 2 of The Tidings. It is simple but sometimes the best prayers are those from the heart—Fr Michael
