

MESSAGE FROM FR MICHAEL

A child is born—during this season we celebrate the birth of Christ. The One the prophets spoke about to our ancestors. Each year we reflect on the birth of Christ and the image of him laying in a manager. Our Gospel begins with the words "In the beginning was the Word; the Word was with God and the Word was God." This reading talks of the word of God that became flesh and dwelt among us, and that we saw his glory. It is easy to be soothed into seeing the image of the Holy family in a tired, cliched way. If we were to put ourselves in this story, how different the image would be. The reason Mary and Joseph were so far away from their family and birth support team was because Caesar Augustus called a census! Mary and Joseph travelled for approximately a week to Joseph's ancestorial home—the city of David, Bethlehem. There was no internet so they could not pre-book accommodation or find an Airbnb. Instead they had to rely on each other and on God. When the couple arrived, there was no room in the inn and they were turned away from any form of decent accommodation. Instead they were offered accommodation in an area that normally housed animals. The smell would not have been pleasant or the surroundings very hygienic. It is a far cry from our modern hospitals. Yet it was there that God chose for His son to be born. The miracle of birth would have been amplified not just because of WHO was being born but HOW He was born. No modern birthing apparatus, no midwife—just a couple experiencing childbirth of their first child in a space that was not designed for human babies to be born in. If something went wrong, who would assist? Their faith would have needed to be huge. While the angels, shepherds, and wisemen came for a visit, they were basically a young couple with a new baby. A baby they knew would fulfil the scriptures. Both Mary and Joseph would have both studied these sacred texts—the birth of THIS child would have been an intimidating task even for the bravest of the brave! No doubt they had the usual first time parent worries but this added pressure would have tested many. While I was born in a taxi outside Kardinia Park, I think this couple had it worse! What so you think?....
