NEW AUXILIARY BISHOPS APPOINTED FOR MELBOURNE

It is with great joy we welcome the Holy Father's appointments of **Reverend Monsignor Anthony Ireland and Reverend Father Martin Ashe** as our two new Auxiliary Bishops for the Archdiocese of Melbourne. The Episcopal Ordinations are scheduled to take place on **Saturday 31 July at 10.30am in St Patrick's Cathedral, Melbourne**. Once ordained Bishop-elect Anthony Ireland will be appointed Episcopal Vicar of the Southern Region and Bishop-elect Martin Ashe as Episcopal Vicar of the Western Region.
