Dear Parents

Welcome to the Parish of Melton Sacramental Program. We as a Parish will support you as you prepare your child to receive the Sacrament of Eucharist.

Parents are the first and foremost teachers of the faith for their children. If parents teach by example and by word, children will grow up to be people of Faith – believing in a loving and forgiving God and living a life of love and concern for others.

Several years ago we began a program of parents meetings to enable parents to feel confident in sharing their faith in their family and to help parents prepare their children to receive the sacraments of Penance, Eucharist and Confirmation.

The Sacraments are celebration of the life and love of Jesus, they are not magic moments, therefore it is absolutely essential that parents understand each sacrament in order to help and support their child.

Our faith is a living, growing journey with our God. Children deserve the best, all the support, love and care we can give.

In the Parish of Melton we begin with helping our children to understand God's presence in our world, the role of the Church in the world, the story of our faith (the Bible) and the place of prayer in our lives.

**PENANCE PROGRAM:** for children who are in Year 3 or older.

**EUCARIST PROGRAM:** only after Penance Program – for children who are in Year 4 or older.

**CONFIRMATION PROGRAM:** only after Penance and Eucharist Program for children who are in Year 6 or older.

In order for our faith to be real and active our support and encouragement must ring true. Like many parishes throughout the Archdiocese of Melbourne, we, at the Parish of Melton pledge to support and help parents as far as possible.
