### Study Options:

You can gain accreditation or enhance your pedagogical practice and leadership by enrolling:

- in an approved course
- in a single unit for credit (see options overleaf)
- as an audit student (without assessment or credit)
- in professional development modules through the semester
- for the 2-day Catholic Dialogue School Seminar

For those who are ready for advanced learning and research the Graduate Certificate in Research Methodologies can lead on to the Master of Theology by Research or the Doctor of Philosophy.

*Audit students participating in recognised units may gain approved hours towards Accreditation to Teach in a Catholic School (CECV Policy 1.6).*

- Master of Theological Studies

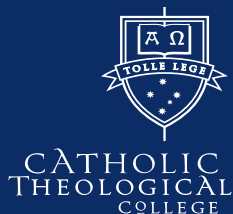
### Fees

- Postgraduate: \$2,640 per 24-point unit
- Single unit for credit: \$2,640 per unit
- Audit: \$650 per unit
- Professional Development Sessions: \$55 per session
