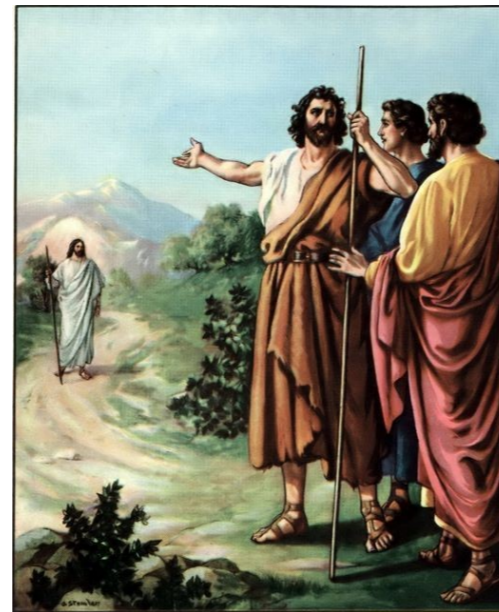
Here I am Lord;
