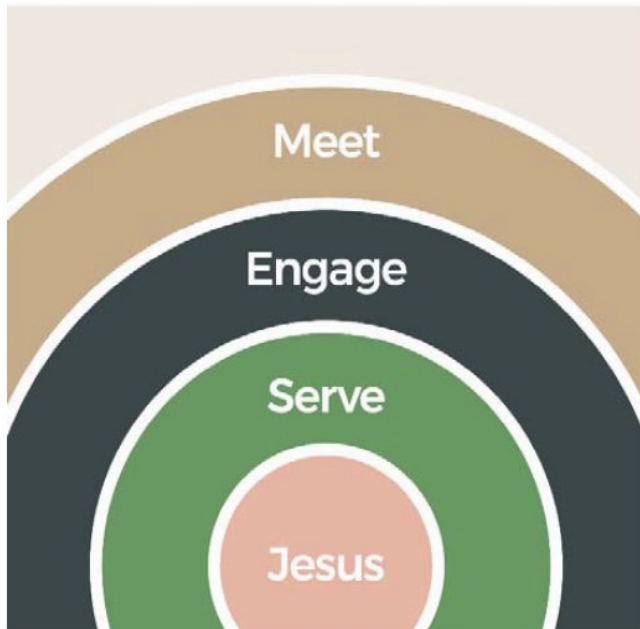

Dear Friends

Our own Parish Community Centre is nearing completion. It is intended to be a warm community hub alongside the spiritual hubs that are our two churches and the educational hubs in our two schools.

I presented this possibility to the Parish Advisory Group after September 2017 when the Sisters of St Paul of Chartres moved to their own home in Chelsea. The PAG enthusiastically embraced the concept and have become impatient to see it completed.

Many of you have had a glimpse of the garden that is taking shape between the sacristy area and the 'old convent'. The architect has poured heart and soul into our project so that, in its physical presentation, it reflects the purpose of the complex. The garden is in a cruciform shape that gathers in worshippers accessing from the church, school children accessing from the Foundation Area, and parishioners and visitors from Childers, Rogers and Mitchell Streets. The interior finishes are inviting and welcoming.

I anticipate that all our current parish

groups will find the centre suited to their purpose. The parish office will relocate, and there is an office for the priest to meet parishioners. There will even be a sick bay.

The kitchen has been upgraded to enable simple catering for meetings, and small groups taking part in a funeral or a baptism.

Thanks to the foresight of previous priests and the faithful giving of parishioners, our historic surplus enables us to meet the costs of the repurposing of the building.

Pray for Archbishop Peter

This weekend (Saturday 29 June) Archbishop Peter received the blessed Pallium from Pope Francis. The Pallium is a small woollen vestment (like a scarf) which is worn over Mass vestments to signify his role as the Metropolitan Archbishop of Melbourne. The Pope blesses the Pallium for each new Metropolitan Archbishop each year on the Feast of Ss Peter and Paul, and the Archbishops who receive it come back to their cities where the Apostolic Nuncio (Papal Ambassador) will formally impose the Pallium as a sign of his unity with the Pope and the Universal Church. Let us pray that this moment for Archbishop Peter as our chief shepherd in Melbourne; for all of our priests, deacons and seminarians, and for many more vocations to priesthood, diaconate and consecrated life.
