World Day of Prayer

Pope Francis has declared 8th February to be the **World Day of Prayer Reflection and Action against Human Trafficking for the Universal Church**. He chose this day because it is the feast day of St Josephine Bakhita, patron saint of Sudan and of Trafficked People. St. Josephine Bakhita was kidnapped as a child from Africa and sold into slavery in the Sudan and in Italy before being freed and becoming a Canossian Sister. A vigil Mass will be celebrated by Archbishop Peter Comensoli at 7.30pm on **Thursday 7th February 2019 in St. Patrick's Cathedral**. All are most welcome.
