St Peter Preaches to the Jews at Pentecost

FATHER MICHAEL'S MESSAGE

I hope that the two prayers printed today will help our celebration of the Solemnity of Pentecost, the solemn feast of the Holy Spirit.

The sobre phrases of the Veni sancte Spiritus lead us to personal gratitude for God's gift of the Spirit who vivifies, accompanies and protects the Church.

Equally, we can be prompted to self-examination lest we allow our heart in its response to God to be dried up, wounded, stubborn, frozen or wayward. The Spirit comes to our aid, healing us through its seven gifts.

The consolation of the Spirit, 'coolness in the heat', is expressed in the meditation by Henry Viscardi. It is an appropriate prayer as we Catholics are experiencing challenging days. It's a prayer that may lift up any survivor of injustice of any kind.

Finally, as the Voluntary Assisted Dying law takes effect in ten day's time, Pope Francis has issued this short message on his Twitter feed:

Euthanasia and assisted suicide are a defeat for all. We are called never to abandon those who are suffering, never giving up but caring and loving to restore hope.
