Dear Parishioners,

In recent years we have seen a remarkable growth in St Patrick's School and we are very proud of the education that we are providing for Catholic families from our Parish. We currently have 387 students at our school which is a growth of approximately 50 students over the past five years. Consequently, we needed to implement our Masterplan which involved adding six new classrooms to the school providing us with the ability to be a triple stream school.

We completed a funding application two years ago and this was submitted to Melbourne Archdiocese Catholic Schools (MACS) and the Victorian Government and we were successful. The project will cost 3.4 million dollars and the Victorian Government are funding 1.7 million of the project which has been amazing for our school. As you would have seen the project is underway and we are hoping to have the program completed by the end of May.

The project will provide us with a redevelopment of the junior wing giving us eleven new classrooms and will join the main building to the junior wing and the junior wing to the O'Hanlon Centre. This means the whole school will be connected providing access to all buildings for all members of the community.

We are very excited to commence this project and we are sure that this will allow us to continue to provide our students with some of the best facilities a Catholic primary school can provide.
