HALIMA FROM BANGLADESH

Halima is raising two children under seven in a refugee camp in Bangladesh, while caring for her mother who has a disability. Widowed at just 21, Halima fled violence in Myanmar's Rakhine State in 2017, arriving at the camp with nothing.

Caritas trained her in domestics. She then took on the role of community trainer herself, organising the cleaning of washrooms, wells and toilets. Her training became all the more invaluable as the COVID-19 pandemic struck - when safe hygiene and preventative measures suddenly became lifesaving. Halima aspired to 'Be More' for her family and for the community around her.
