World Day of Prayer

Pope Francis has declared 8th February to be the World Day of Prayer Reflection and Action against Human Trafficking for the Universal Church. He chose this day because it is the feast day of St Josephine Bakhita, patron saint of Sudan and of Trafficked People. St. Josephine Bakhita was kidnapped as a child from Africa and sold into slavery in the Sudan and in Italy before being freed and becoming a Canossian Sister. A vigil Mass will be celebrated by Archbishop Peter A. Comensoli at 7.30pm on **Thursday 7th February 2019 in St. Patrick's Cathedral.** All are most welcome.
