PREEMINENCE OF THE MASS AS A LITURGICAL ACTION

For the next three weeks, I offer some thoughts, both theological and practical, about our celebration of Mass at St Patrick's.

Part One: Theological Principles of the Eucharist.

Our reflection receives a sound orientation from the GENERAL INSTRUCTION ON THE ROMAN MISSAL.

Citing both the Council of Trent and the Second Vatican Council, GIRM states in #2:

'At the Last Supper our Saviour instituted the Eucharistic Sacrifice of his Body and Blood, by which he would perpetuate the Sacrifice of the Cross throughout the centuries until he should come again, thus entrusting to the Church, his beloved Bride, the memorial of his death and resurrection.'

The Missal teaches us that 'the Sacrifice of the Cross and its sacramental renewal in the Mass ... are one and the same. (They differ)

only in the manner of offering. Consequently the Mass is at once a sacrifice of praise and thanksgiving, of propitiation and satisfaction.'

GIRM #3 reminds us to be reverent towards the Lord's real presence 'by that interior disposition and outward expression of supreme reverence and adoration in which the Eucharistic Liturgy is carried out.'

Our adoring reverence is the action of us all, explained in GIRM #5:

'The nature of the ministerial priesthood puts into its proper light another reality, which must indeed be highly regarded, namely, the royal priesthood of the faithful, whose spiritual sacrifice is brought to completeness through the ministry of the Bishop and the priests in union with the Sacrifice of Christ, the one and only Mediator.'

#5 continues with a synthesis of the parts of the Mass, as highlighted below. We are GATHERED, nourished by GOD'S WORD, INTERCEDING for the world, GIVING THANKS, OFFERING CHRIST'S SACRIFICE, in COMMUNION with Christ and one another:

For the celebration of the Eucharist is an action of the whole Church, and in it each one should carry out solely but completely that which pertains to him or her, in virtue of the rank of each within the People of God. In this way greater consideration will also be given to some aspects of the celebration that have sometimes been accorded less attention in the course of time. For this people is the People of God, purchased by Christ's Blood, gathered together by the Lord, nourished by his word. It is a people called to bring to God the prayers of the entire human family, a people giving thanks in Christ for the mystery of salvation by offering his Sacrifice. Finally, it is a people made one by sharing in the Communion of Christ's Body and Blood. Though holy in its origin, this people nevertheless grows continually in holiness by its conscious, active, and fruitful participation in the mystery of the Eucharist.

Next week, I will consider the Eucharistic Action in the Presence of the Blessed Sacrament.
