Gospel Reflection:

AUSTRALIA DAY

South Land of the Holy Spirit

Australia is a place to which people have been attracted over the millennia to forge a new future. First, the original inhabitants coming down through Asia, and then the settlers, migrants and refugees of the last 220 years. (Of course, the convicts were a less voluntary part of the movement of peoples!)

Most were attracted by a vision of a different future, a future where human beings could relate to each other differently to the old order in Europe, and more recently in the Middle East or Africa or Asia or Central or South

People were and are prepared to take the risk of being dis-located, of re-locating because of that vision of a different future, particularly a future not determined by the violence of feud and warfare which had characterised their homelands for generations, centuries, and even millennia.

Those mapping expeditions gave us our name 'Australia'? De Quiros, the great Portuguese explorer of the 16th Century, set out on a quest for 'Terra Austrialia del Espiritu Santo', South Land of the Holy Spirit. Right from the start, the full title of our land was bound up with the Holy Spirit.

2019 PARISH RENEWAL PROGRAM RESULTS. On behalf of my fellow priest Father Shymon, members of the Parish Renewal Program team and our entire parish staff, we want you to know how much we appreciate your presence and participation in our parish communities. It's been an eventful past two months and we would not have achieved our Program results without the engagement of parishioners who offered their time and God-given talents and financial pledge commitments. Effective 22 December 2019, Christ the Light Catholic Parish has pledged Stewardship income of \$2,809 per week (a 40% increase) from 204 givers, i.e. 171 existing and 33 new contributors. Your willingness to be part of our Groups and Ministries has resulted in 92 parishioners committing to help support everything that we do. Thank you all very much. With sincere gratitude, Fr Martin.
