

## **Sacraments**

#### **BAPTISM**

The Baptism Preparation Program is a five-step process:

- 1. Contact the coordinator.
- 2. A visit by the coordinator to your home to outline the process and confirm your dates.
- 3. Take part in a preparation session with your child's godparents.
- 4. Rite of Welcome ceremony the week before your child's baptism.
- 5. Sacrament of Baptism.

The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated at the following times:

Mernda: 12 noon (1st and 3rd Sunday of the month) at the Nazareth Centre, St Joseph's Primary School, 44 Mernda Village Drive, Mernda

Whittlesea: 11.15 am (2nd and 4th Sunday of the month) at St Mary's Church, Fir Street, Whittlesea

**Kinglake:** 8.30 am Mass at St Mary's Church, Main Road, Kinglake

#### RECONCILIATION, COMMUNION, AND CONFIRMATION

The celebration of the sacraments of Reconciliation (Penance), First Eurcharist (Communion), and Confirmation include the family, school, and parish community. Children are prepared for the reception of these sacraments at an appropriate age level which is:

#### Year 3 for Reconciliation Year 4 for Eucharist Year 6 for Confirmation

Children enrolled in Catholic schools participate in a program which assists in their understanding of the sacraments. In cases of children attending schools other than Catholic, a program is presented over a number of weeks. Parents are encouraged to attend these sessions with their child as additional activities are undertaken at home. All children and their families preparing for any of these sacraments are expected to attend Faith Evenings as circulated, as well as Sunday Mass.
