Dear Parishioners,

In the light of the recent Government restrictions we are very fortunate that we can still have Mass with a congregation, unlike the parishes that have been placed under level 3 restrictions once again.

Also please be aware people living in the 'Hotzone' suburbs are not permitted to attend Mass in churches outside the 'hotzones.' This means we are not free to invite people from those parishes to our church for regular scheduled Masses.

For those who wish to attend Mass please follow the booking directions.

- Firstly, you can reserve a place online through TryBooking by going to this week's Trybooking page www.trybooking.com/ BKGDK (each week's link will also be available on our website). Bookings will open at 11 am each Monday for the week ahead (Tuesday to Monday). If you are booking for others please include their names.
- Secondly, if you don't have internet access you can reserve a place by phoning 9407 6701 between 11 am and 1 pm on
- Thirdly, you can take a chance and simply come to the church to see if there are any places available, however simply showing up does not guarantee you a place.

We ask that you only book in for one Mass a week and if you are able to attend Mass during the week please give consideration to others who are not able to attend weekday Masses, so they may attend a Sunday Mass. We will only take bookings one week at a time. If you have booked for Mass online and are no longer able to attend we ask that you click the cancellation link in the confirmation email you were sent to enable someone else to access the spot.

Remember the obligation to attend Sunday Mass is still suspended by the Archbishop.

**Sunday Morning Mass** 

Our Mass timetable is as follows:

Saturday Vigil Mass 5:00 pm

9:00 am & 11:00 am (not 10:30 am)

**Sunday Evening Mass** 5:00 pm

Weekday Mass Monday to Saturday

9:15 am

Weekday Mass Tuesday to Thursday

7:00 pm

Confessions will be heard each Saturday morning from 9:45 am - 10:30 am.

Doors will be opened for each Mass 15 minutes prior to the start of Mass. Once Mass begins the doors will be closed. All people will need to vacate the church no later than 15 minutes after Mass finishes. Please note carefully; if you are running late we are not permitted to allow you entry.

The Church will also be open each afternoon from Tuesday to Friday at 3:00 pm. All who attend must continue to supply their name and phone number and sanitise their hands.

The following conditions upon entry are:

- If you have booked, you will need to have your name ticked on the list.
- If you have not booked (provided spaces are available), you will need to give your name and phone number.
- All people are to sanitise their hands and maintain a 1.5 metre distance from others.
- Please sit in the designated pews between the crosses marked on the pews.
- Entrance and exit doors will be the main doors of the church. The door that is part of the stain glass window is not to be accessed at any time.

We have been asked to distribute Holy Communion in the hand. After Mass the entire church will be disinfected. Newsletters are to be taken home or put in the waste bin and not left in the church as re-using newsletters is not permissible. There will be no music (except for the 9:00 am Mass that will be streamed online) or offertory processions, and no sign of peace. There will be no passing of collection baskets but a collection box will be in the porch of the church.

Please be aware the church will be closed for maintenance from Monday 13th to Saturday 18th July. There will be a revised Mass program in the hall. Details to follow.
