Our Archbishop Peter Comensoli wrote a column in one of our daily papers during the week highlighting the need to make Mass more accessible. I quote him in part, "Parishes are not places of mere formality, but of lively and attentive care to vulnerable people, and of support to those facing sickness, loneliness, grief and death. They are places of hope and wellbeing, and of spiritual friendship." With these sentiments in mind the Archbishop has asked us to write to our local members of parliament expressing our hope we may be treated fairly. We are not asking for special consideration, we are only asking for equal consideration.

### Re Unfair treatment of People of Faith in the COVID-19 Roadmap

Dear Mrs/Ms/Mr XXXXXXX,

With respect, I ask that you hear the concerns of people of faith like myself, and request the government to urgently address the unfair treatment of faith communities in the state COVID-19 Roadmap.

The announcement on Sunday 18 October of some easing of restrictions in metropolitan and regional Victoria failed to recognise the spiritual needs and wellbeing supports of religious faith. Not only that, but the proposals for Step Three of the Roadmap ahead still force religious people, including the disabled, the elderly, and families with young children, to worship outside.

As venues like restaurants and pubs open up, it makes no sense that people of faith are forced to stand outside in small numbers, locked out of their most sacred place.

Places of worship, be they churches, temples, mosques or synagogues, provide an essential service, even if that can't be reduced to a dollar value by the government.

Faith leaders have enforced COVID-safe plans and all other measures ever since the Pandemic began and should now be able to gather with their people in numbers equivalent to other sectors such as hospitality.

All I seek is equality and fairness.
