Dear Parishioners,


We welcome people back to the celebration of Mass for the first time in a long time. But we have good news and bad news. The good news is we are open. The bad news is we have a number of complications to deal with. As our state has reached the 70% double vaccinated target we are able to have 20 people at Mass who are fully vaccinated (Government limit). That applies to anyone who is 16 years and older. These Masses will be at our regular Mass times of Saturday 5 pm, Sunday 9 am, Sunday 10:30 am and Sunday 5 pm. For those people who are not vaccinated once, twice, or at all, we will have 2 extra Masses each weekend in the Chapel for 10 people (Government limit). These will be Saturday at 6:30 pm and Sunday at 7:30 am. At all Masses people will be required to book in online or by phone and QR code check in as you enter. Bookings for next weekend will open on Tuesday 26th October at 10 am. All children under 12 months of age are exempt from the booking limits. All people are required to wear face masks and sanitise your hands on the way into the Church and before the reception of Holy Communion. Proof of vaccination or a medical exemption must be provided each time you come to Mass. Putting it simply, NO PROOF = NO ENTRY. We will resume weekday Masses when we are secure in the knowledge our system is working. Many thanks to all who are vaccinated for your vaccination has enabled us to re-open.

ORDINATION NEWS - Our parishioner Rev Jaycee Napoles was informed by the Archbishop that he and the other deacons will be ordained on Saturday 4th December at St Patrick's Cathedral. Please keep him in your prayers along with the other young men to be ordained priests and deacons.
