PARISH OFFICE - The office staff have returned to work. Office hours are 8:30 am to 4:30 pm Monday to Friday.



The message is clear. Set them free! Religious leaders from across the faiths are calling on Prime Minister Scott Morrison and Leader of the Opposition, Anthony Albanese to release refugees and asylum seekers that are still being held in detention. Leaders representing a wide cross section of faiths officially launched the campaign last Friday at St Paul's Cathedral in Melbourne with the release of a short film, #SetThemFree. The film highlights the plight of refugees still held in indefinite detention, including in Melbourne's notorious Park Hotel.

In Melbourne, 28 asylum seekers are currently detained in the Park Hotel on Swanston Street, while 14 are still being detained at the Melbourne Immigration Transit Accommodation in Broadmeadows. Fifteen others are detained in Perth, Brisbane, Sydney, including two women, and just over 200 are still being held in Nauru and Papua New Guinea.
