

Saints Who Suffered Serious Illness - Saint Sigfrid

Feast: 22 August

In the 7th century, the outstanding saint of northern England was Benedict Biscop, archbishop and founder of the Abbeys of Wear-mouth and Jarrow. During his life, Benedict made five trips to the European continent to collect manuscripts, relics, and precious art for his monks. In his absence, he appointed abbots to run the monasteries in his stead. During Benedict's fifth trip, Eosterwine, the Abbot of Wearmouth, died, and the deacon Sigfrid was chosen to replace him. According to Saint Bede, Sigfrid was "a man well-skilled in the knowledge of Holy Scripture, of most excellent manners, of wonderful continence". Yet he suffered greatly from "a baneful and incurable affection of the lungs." When Benedict returned, he and Sigfrid led together as co-abbots. Both were soon struck with serious illness, Sigfrid with advanced lung disease and Benedict with paralysis. As both men drew close to death, they desired to see each other one last time. The monks carried Benedict to Sigfrid's room on a litter, and the men were laid next to each other. Since neither man had the strength to embrace the other, the monks helped them. Two months later, "having passed through the fire and water of temporal tribulation", Sigfrid died. Benedict followed him into eternal life four months after that.

Eternal Father, through the intercession of Saint Sigfrid, give me companions in my old age.
