Dear Parishioners,

With all of the new directives we have received from our Archbishop which required immediate implementation we have found ourselves struggling to put into place measures that will assist the spiritual welfare of our parishioners but we will persevere.

The most striking directive is the immediate suspension of all public liturgies, including the celebrations of Mass until further notice. However funerals, weddings, baptisms and confessions will still continue.

Furthermore, all our other gatherings are suspended. That means all parish groups are requested not to convene until further notice.

Sadly there will be no Easter Ceremonies.

All the faithful are now dispensed from attending Sunday Mass. It is hoped people will spend some time on Sundays praying or reading the scriptures or watching Mass For You at Home (6) am Sundays on channel 10).

Also we will be live streaming Mass each Sunday and each Wednesday at 8am.

The Church will be open for visits each day from 9 am until 12 noon. The chapel will remain open as usual.

CONTRIBUTIONS

I know many of you will be concerned about keeping up to date with your thanksaivina contribution. For those who contribute by direct debit or credit card all will remain in place. For those who contribute using envelopes a collection box has been placed at the parish office each day where you can simply drop off your offering on any day at any time or you can leave it with the office staff.

Even though the Masses have ceased the ongoing financial commitments of the Parish remain. If you would like to switch your contributions to direct debit or credit card this is a timely moment and the office staff will be able to assist you or you can download the forms from our website www.cam.org.au/millpark and email them to us at millpark@cam.org.au If I may further request from you. Many who contribute using envelopes give little or even nothing to the presbytery side of the envelopes. Not only does this support your local priests but it is also needed to assist the priests in parishes with minimal support, priests who are sick and infirm and retired priests.
