The Holy Father reminds the faithful that the Lenten practices of fasting, almsgiving and prayer make it possible for us to live lives of sincere faith, living hope and effective charity, thereby sharing in Jesus' mission of the salvation of the world.

Face masks are required for all people 12 years and older. The wearing of masks allows us to have greater numbers in the church than otherwise.


