Saint Who? Saint Adelaide Feast day: 16 December

Adelaide was a Burgundian princess. Born in 931, she was betrothed to the prince of a neighbouring region as part of a peace treaty. She was two when the contract was made, and at sixteen she was married to Lothair, king of Italy. The couple had one daughter, but then Lothair died. His rival (and possibly murderer) tried to force Adelaide to wed his son, but she refused.

One account says that she escaped from prison but became entrapped in a bog. In a moment of despair, she encountered Otto the Great, king of Germany, who not only rescued her but fell in love with her at first sight. The two married and had five children together. Otto became Holy Roman Emperor. After twenty years of marriage, Otto died. Adelaide left the court, fleeing conflicts with her son and daughter-in-law. However, with the help of wise counsellors, she succeeded in being reconciled to them. Eventually she became a regent of the empire, which she ruled until her grandson came of age. Then Adelaide left to devote her time to the establishment of churches and religious houses. She died on 16 December 999, in a monastery she had helped establish. She is the patron saint of second marriages.
