### MASS BOOKINGS NO LONGER REQUIRED

From now on, all those who wish to attend Mass will not need to pre-book, but will need to check in via QR code upon arrival. We are now required to use the Victorian Government QR system (a slightly different QR code to the one we have used previously). It will be even more important to come to Mass at least 20 minutes early to avoid delaying Mass. It would help greatly if all parishioners could please download the Service Victoria app before attending Mass next Sunday by going to https://service.vic.gov.au/check-in/ and downloading the app either through the App Store (for Apple phones) or the Google Play Store (for Android phones). We will have QR monitors with iPads available to check in those without a phone. Please be aware that entry is not permitted once Mass begins. We thank you for your understanding.


