### WELCOME TO THE RELIGIOUS SISTERS FROM BELARUS

On weekend April 29 – April 30, 2017 at our Parish Masses we shall extend a warm welcome to the Sisters from St. Elisabeth's Convent, Minsk, Republic of Belarus. The Sisters with others take care of the mentally-challenged children and adults. The care of these children is particularly demanding as they live with Down syndrome, birth traumas and congenial physical defects. Many die quite young. The adult patients require constant support particularly as their social skills are so limited.

In recent years, a Shelter for former drug and alcohol-addicted persons has been established some distance from the Convent. This has meant many homeless, struggling and lost people are getting a chance at a new start in life and coming to know the love of God.

In order to further assist with this work of care and outreach the Sisters have welcomed the organisation of some Workshops on the premises of the Convent, engaged with the Religious in the production of hand painted Icons, Crosses & Crucifixes, Wood Carvings, Embroidered & Ceramic gifts, Rosaries & Vestments. It is with love that the Sisters bring to us this weekend a selection of these goods made with love and prayer and an occasion of blessings to those who chose to own them. The Sisters will have these available at Masses.
