Dear Parishioners,

As I mentioned last week the easing of restrictions have now made it permissible for people to visit the Church to pray. Consequently the Chapel will be open this week to allow people to pray before the Lord. However, there are a range of protocols that are required to be observed for this to take place.

The Chapel will be available for prayer from Tuesday 26th May to Friday 29th May. Only ten people are permitted to be in the Chapel at any time. There are no bookings. Simply the first ten people who arrive for each session will be admitted.

The times available are as follows:

Morning times Afternoon times
10:00 am - 10:30 am
11:00 am - 11:30 am
12:00 pm - 12:30 pm
4:00 pm - 4:30 pm

- Once we have 10 people in the Chapel no more may enter until the next session.
- The sessions are strictly not to exceed 30 minutes.
- If you arrive late through a session you may not make up the time in the next session or stay after the expiry time.
- Only one session per person per day.
- · Hands must be sanitised before entering. Sanitisers will be made available inside the Chapel.
- Each person must write their first name and telephone number on the record sheets located inside the Chapel.
- You may sit on any one of the ten chairs available.
- Chairs are not to be moved.
- · Prayer is to be silent only; group or vocal recitations of any prayer is not to take place.
- Please do not talk inside the Chapel.

This week will be something of a introductory period. Different approaches may be incorporated as time goes on. So please bear in mind we are taking a trial and error approach. If it becomes apparent we need to introduce a booking system, we will do so.

The hours may be extended to other days and other times but we need to gauge people's needs and responses. We are very happy to receive feedback from all parishioners.

If the government allows greater numbers to visit churches we will open the church.

With regards to Masses, only ten people are allowed to be present at Mass which is inadequate to our needs, however once restrictions are eased which will allow a significant number of people to attend Mass we will certainly have Masses said publicly once again. In the meantime, Masses will continue to be streamed online.

And on another note thank you to all who are praying for the needs of the parish and are supporting the parish with your Thanksgiving contributions.
