SAINT WHO?

Saints Who Rescued Widows and Orphans

The Gospel is the story of a love that seeks, finds, and gathers: the woman hunting her lost coin, the shepherd going after his sheep, the father welcoming his wayward son. Before our Lord showed us the lengths to which he would go for us on the cross, he told us of that love in his parables.

The early Church did as her Lord had taught her. She gathered the abandoned and consoled the bereft. In Jerusalem, one of the Apostles' first concerns was the continuation of charity to needy widows (cf. Acts 6). And in Rome, the deacon Lawrence was asked to bring the Church's funds to the authorities. He gave the money to the poor and the orphans, and brought *them* to the magistrate: "the Church's true treasure".

In our own day, Pope Benedict XVI plainly proclaimed: "Love for widows and orphans, prisoners, and the sick and needy of every kind is as essential to [the Church] as the ministry of the sacraments and the preaching of the Gospel. The Church cannot neglect the service of charity any more than she can neglect the sacraments and the Word" (Deus caritas est 22).

As always, the saints put flesh on the words of the Gospel. This month's saints are the ones who seek and find, gather and nurture. Their concern for abandoned children and destitute women, the rejected of society, is that selfsame love that has been lavished upon us in Christ.

DIRECTIONS FOR THE USE OF THE FELLOWSHIP AREA DURING MASS

- The outer doors of the Church are to remain open at all times during Mass for OH&S requirements.
- At no time should children be permitted to play on the railings in the fellowship area or the garden/ water feature area outside the Church.
